Now, the question is, “What do you do next?” You’ve got the dreams and you’ve got the plan and you know God is there, but what is your role? What are some steps you can take to make dreams happen.

Only twice in the Bible are people referred to as beautiful and Joseph is one of them. His good looks got him in trouble because Potiphar’s wife tried to hook up with Joseph. She waited till he was alone and then asked him to have an affair. Joseph took off so fast his shirt just disappeared. .

Potiphar’s wife didn’t like the response, and she was determined to get back at Joseph. She told her husband that Joseph was trying to get with her, and this just ticked Potiphar off. And the dream was shattered, Joseph was thrown into prison.

I look at a story like this and I see how everything seemed to continue to happen to Joseph. Nothing would go right. It had to be so frustrating for him.

I want to ask the same thing in our lives. As a Christian we are growing in our relationship with God, because all of this is dependent on a growing relationship with God, and we are seeking his will in everything. We just want to do the right thing and serve God, follow his plan and see our dreams come true. But then bad stuff happens or things don't work out the way that we planned. I just want to ask WHY? Why don't things always work out and why do we face difficult situations like Joseph?

Here is an answer to that question: Hebrews 12:7 says, "God is educating you; that's why you must never drop out. He's treating you as dear children. This trouble you're in isn't punishment; it's training."

So that's it. God was with Joseph and during that time he was preparing Joseph, strengthening him, and training him for other things that might come his way in the future.

For us, I see it like this. As we serve God and live out our dreams, all the difficult things we face and every time when things don't work out like we imagine – we need to realize we are in training. We are in training for future things – doing God's work, making our dreams come true, anything. God is working in us to make us more like him, strengthening us, and getting us in shape for life.

All that said, what does it take, what do you have to do to help see God's dreams and your dreams come true in our lives? Let's see what Nacho says about all that.
